STRENGTHENING THE EDIFICE

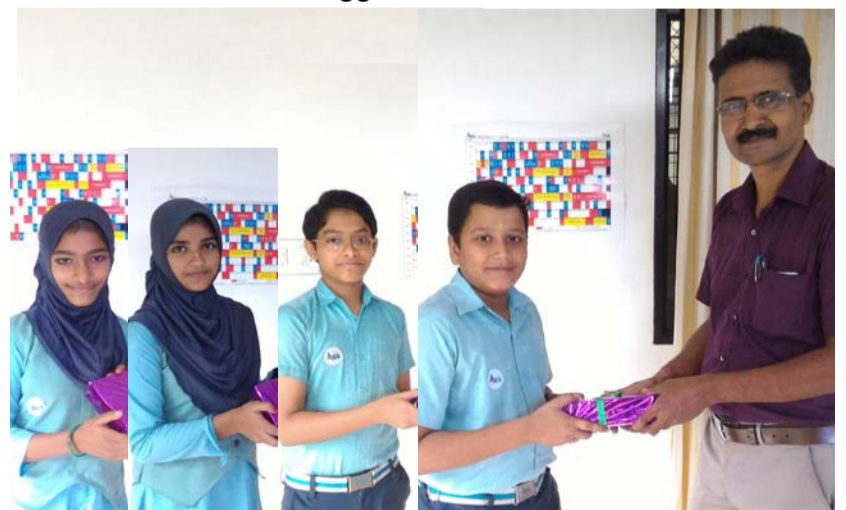
Sunday madrassa, an ambitious venture to extend the arena of moral academic at Ace, got off to a solid beginning on October 4. The

Some famous Mathematicians like Bhaskarajarya, Neelakanda Swamiji and Kadasseri Parameswaran Namboodiri lived in Kerala.

Bhaskarajarya who lived in 1114 AD was also known to be Keralite Mathematician. His main works are Leelavathi, Siddhanta Shiromani, Aryabattium, Mahabhaskarium, Laghu bhaskarium etc. He is known as Indian Euclid or father of Geometry.

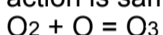
In 17th century western country mathematicians discussed about the value pie and found that it is not a fraction. But before that in 15th century Neelakanda Swamiraj explained it. OZONE - THE PROTECTOR

O₃ or the Ozone is not such a simple roof. It has its own peculiarity and importance. Friends! Have you ever thought that the simple refrigerators and Air Conditioners can also harm us? If you are thinking that these are only giving advantages for us, just reject that thought.

Ozone (O₃) is formed when with the O₂ or Oxygen combines with another O or Oxygen atom. This is a continuous process, thus it will go on like $O_3 + O = 2O_2$.

Now from these $O_2 + O_2$ the process continues and we can understand that the rate of reaction is same for both.

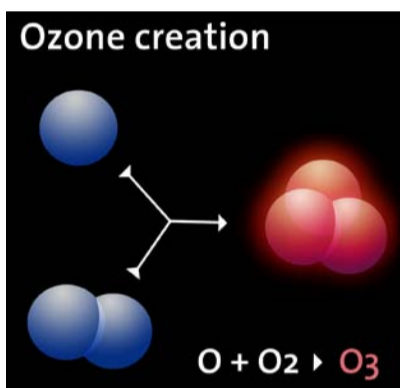


$O_3 + O = 2O_2$ both of these are happening continuously.

Chlorine from CFC and Bromine from Halone catalyze the

second process thus more O₂ are made than O₃. This is how the Ozone depletion happens. Here as O₂ is produced more, the ozone balance would be reduced.

Ozone depletion is being done either by your refrigerator or A/C which gives out CFC, so better be cautious!

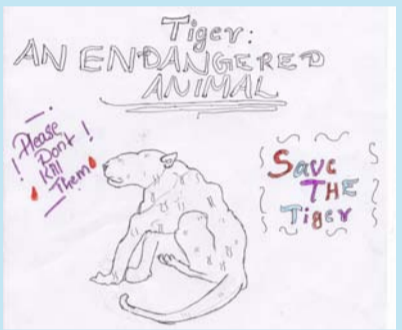

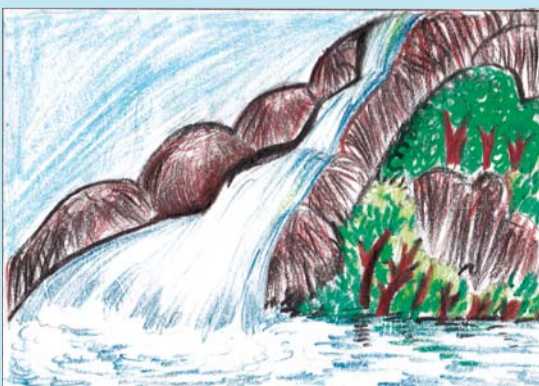
